

LITTER HUNT



You will need **LITTER BAGS, GLOVES** and a **MAP** (of area, school or other location).

Create your list of Items to collect (For example, litter, trash bottles, paper, gum, wrappers, cans, etc. **NOTHING SHARP or HAZARDOUS!**)

Divide the students into small groups.

Give students 15 to 30 minutes to collect as much litter as they can.

After litter collection, have the group examine the collected litter. Categorize the litter and find what the most frequent litter is found.

Have each group present findings:

(A) Which areas had the most litter?

(B) Can litter be recycled or reused in another way?



Talk about how litter can be reduced in your location.
